COLLEGE APPLICATION UPDATE

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov This form is absolutely necessary if you want to apply for federal, state or college aid. Please be aware of each college's deadline. Additionally, some schools require the CSS/Profile, which can be completed at www.collegeboard.com.
- If you haven't already, you should be completing your college applications! Required documentation including official transcripts and letters of recommendation must be sent from the guidance office.
- There is still time to attend open houses and **visit colleges**. If you visit a college during school hours, the absence will be **excused** if you **complete** the **Trip Approval form**, **three days before the scheduled visit**. Forms are available in the guidance office.
- Remember to bring in your college letters of acceptance, conditional standing letters, scholarship offers, and any invitation to special programs you may have received.
