April 30th, 4pm

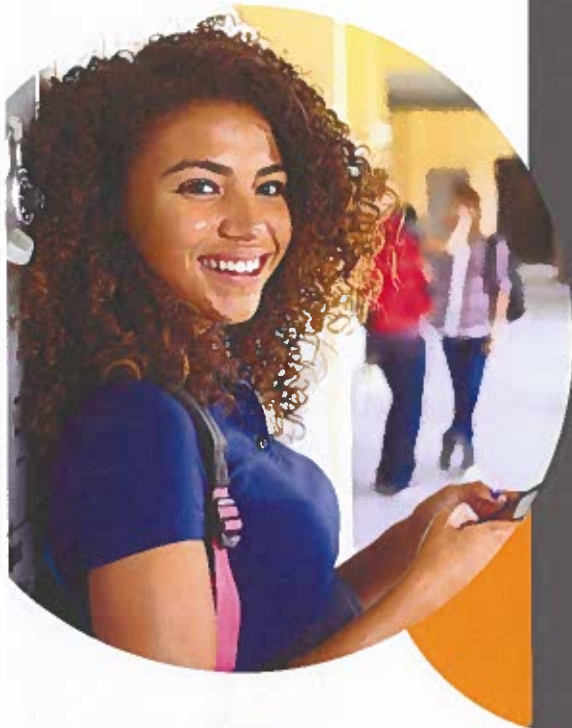
WHO IS ELIGIBLE?
