Please review the following updated information as we prepare for the return to school.

Student Orientation:

All students must attend <u>Student Orientation</u> on campus. The orientation is designed for safety training and to provide for school issued tablet computer distribution and updates. Freshman will receive their devices on the first day of orientation. Existing students' devices must undergo a check to confirm functionality and ensure the latest updates are loaded to support Hybrid/Remote instruction. Students will maintain appropriate six (6) feet social distancing and utilize one classroom of approximately fifteen (15) students during the orientation.

Assignments September 3rd through 18th:

The priority of the Orientation is to ensure safety procedures and necessary training for Hybrid/Remote learning. The Restart Committee has developed the Orientation schedule and is collaborating with the Administration on the assignments for this time. The initial assignments will not require a school issued device to complete. The forthcoming assignments will be sent via email blast, posted to our website, and be supported by classroom teachers.

Entrance locations:

Students entering the building for Orientation and then in-person instruction will enter at designated locations based on residence. Additionally, each grade level has an assigned entry time. Please click this Entrance MAP for Fall 2020 for locations and times.
